Stabling: stables are open from July 25th, 8 am. Early arrival is possible by appointment only! Latest Departure by July 29th, 9 am! Later departures are possible but by appointment only!

Starts: Open for all Arabian horses registered at birth in a WAHO accepted studbook of any ECAHO member country at the time of entry. Geldings are welcome.

Show jumping: time & faults, jump off in case of tie, indoor arena, sand, 30 x 60 m.

Fees:

Nomination: all competitions/classes and paid warm-ups € 12,--, additionally € 1,00 OEPS/FN Sports sponsoring fee.

Entry fees: Event & NC Ch € 25,-- (July 25th & 26th), **Austrian Championship** € 35,-- (July 27th), **European Championship** € 45,-- (July 28th),

Stables: Competition stables, solid stables with automatic water and feeder including shavings for first bedding, € 155,-- for four days (starting July 26th, 8 am, ending July 30th, 9 am). Each additional day € 35,-- including final cleaning. Stables for one day € 80,-- Bedding shavings: first bedding and additional shavings free! Tackbox € 80,--. Stables are obligatory. No horses on trucks, trailers or tents allowed!

Horse food: bale of hay € 12,-- (approx. 18 kg).

Camping lot (with electricity, showers, toilets and camping lot € 45,--/weekend, to be reserved along with the entry form (limited number available!))

Payments: International competitors send the deposit entry fee of € 100, by banking transfer. Bank conditions see entry form.

Special Rules & Regulations:

For all horses the horse's passport has to be shown at the show office. Take care that the passport is completely filled in including the drawings! All horses have to have a correct/valid vaccination history against influenza, every twelve month including the correct basic vaccination. Last vaccination not longer than six months ago. **If in the original country of the horse a coggins test is needed, the horse must also have it at this event**

Internationale participants need for the horsetransport official permit by government (EU-2009/156/EG, II.

All participants, officials or visitors give at the time of nomination or visit, the allowance:

- All the information following (DSGVO) can be used in any way.
- Also that all pictures, videos and announcements are allowed.

Dogs are allowed on the showground but only on a leash!

The final time schedule and order of competitions will be available during the event in the show office. Cancellations or any changes of competitions are in the responsibility of the show manager. Late entries are possible. All competing horses have to be healthy and without any infectious diseases and for each horse a liability insurance is obligatory.

The Dressage competitions will be judged by three judges separately following the FEI rules.

Age rules: Children under control auf experienced adult persons are able to compete at the age of 8 years.

Horses: Handtrail min. age one year, all other classes not special ruled in ECAHO Green Book, the minimum age is three years. E Ch & E Ch qualifier (A Ch) Dressage, Jumping, Reining, min. age six years.

All Pleasure, Trail & western classes minimum age of four years.(Green Book p. 67/§ IV/8)

Western horses six years & older in Bit, exception: Novice classes & Ladies Side Saddle if both styles are together, allowance Snaffle Bit & two hands

Dressage classes will be judged with 3 judges in separate judgement.

Whips in Dressage allowed.

Western horses are allowed to participate six classes per day, Classic horses three (Dressage, Jumping) but six pleasure classes.

Late entries are possible in all classes, lates 19:00 the day before.

ATTENTION: Show jumping & Pleasure Driving competitions will be cancelled if there are less than 6 entries at the deadline of nomination. 22.06.2019

All Championships are open for all participants from all Austrian countries & all International competitors.

International ECAHO European Championships

The title Champion will be given for: Dressage, Western Pleasure, Trail, Reining, Show Jumping, Classic Pleasure, Traditional Arabian Riding, Ladies Side Saddle (western & classic), Pleasure Driving, Western All Around & Classic All Around.

For the European Champion title a minimum of three horses have to compete in the competition. If there are less horses, no Champion title will be given and the competition will become a normal one.

For the Championship: 1st place: a sash and trophy, 1st-3rd place: a Gold, Silver, Bronze medal, 1st-6th place: a rosette

International ECAHO Austrian Championships

The title Champion will be given for: Western Pleasure, Trail, Reining, Dressage, Show Jumping, Classic Pleasure, Traditional Arabian Riding, Ladies Side Saddle (western & classic), Pleasure Driving.

For the title a minimum of three horses have to compete in the competition. If there are less horses, no Champion title will be given and the competition will become a normal one.

For the Championship: 1st place: a trophy & sash, 1st-3rd place: a Gold, Silver, Bronze medal, 1st-6th place: a rosette

All other competitions/classes: 1st – 6th place a rosette

International ECAHO New comer Championships

The title Champion will be given for: Western Pleasure, Trail, Reining, Dressage, Show Jumping, Classic Pleasure, Traditional Arabian Riding, Ladies Side Saddle (western & classic), Pleasure Driving.

For the title a minimum of three NC horses have to compete in the competition. If there are less horses, no Champion title will be given and the competition will become a normal one.

All horses are able to compete. the overqualified ones will collect the points for the E Ch All Around Championship but will be not in the prize giving of NC Ch. In NC Ch only horses & rider combination are in the ranking they never before reached 1.-3.place in E Ch or A Ch.

For the Championship: 1st place: a trophy & sash, 1st-3rd place: a Gold, Silver, Bronze medal, 1st-6th place: a rosette

All other competitions/classes: 1st – 6th place: a rosette

Pleasure Championship CI & W the 3 best Pleasure results Classic or Western from 26. & 27 & Type & Conformation count together by points. Trophy for the winner, rosettes 1.-6.

Best Junior CI & Best Junior W Horse of the event (4 & 5 years) all results from all classes will be count together. 1 Point Novice counts 1 point, 1 point Advanced counts 2 points and one point Master counts 3 points. The highest total of points will be the winner. Trophy for the winners, 1.- 6. rosettes

ECAHO Super Bowl, Best Nation in Sport from all participants of one Nation the points of the whole event will count together. 1 Novice point = 1, 1 Advanced point = 2, 1 Master point = 3 Pkt., If a Nation will win the Super Bowl for three times it will be given to this Nation and will stay with them forever.

The Nation of a **horse** is clear declared in the horse passport as that Nationality the horse is registered at the deadline of entry.

This event is specific for WAHO accepted Arabians.

The horse will win the title, the sash and the rosettes. The rider will earn the medal.

ATTENTION: Starting possibilities: N (Novice) + A (Advanced), A + M (Masters), this means the same horse can compete with a different rider in either N+A and with another rider in A+M. The riders competing in Championship competitions can also compete with a different horse in N+A. These are not allowed to participate in Championship competitions.

Each rider is allowed to start a maximum of 3 horses in the Championship competitions.

All Pleasure classes, Side saddle, Traditional Arabian and Horsemanship classes with 16 & more will be split. It is up to the organizer to split with less competitors in a pleasure & HMS class to give the riders with more than one horse the chance to start them. After the short pleasure of split classes the judges decides finally the ten best of all pre rounds for the finals or qualifier. The judges will decide what horse the riders with more than one will come in, if more than one is good.

To help the competitor it is allowed that a helper/second rider warms up the horse. But no changing of riders is allowed at the Championship competitions. The rider/horse-combination stays the same during all Championship competitions including Type & Conformation.

The Show Office will take care of riders who want to compete with more than one horse concerning the starting order. There will be enough time between the starts, but no extra preparation time for the horses will be given.

Dressage tests: up to L/M (possible with announcement). The rider has to bring his/her own speaker and let the show office know in time.

European Western All Around Champion & European Classic All Around Champion

All Master/M & E Ch Competitions count together, plus Type & Conformation. A minimum two different disciplines and T & C obligatory.

Prize giving ceremonies: All riders placed in the medals have to participate correctly dressed with the horse under saddle at the final prize giving ceremonies. Those who are not present with the winning horse will lose their awards and the next placed horse will get into place. If a rider has more than one horse in the prize giving ceremony, a helper has to lead the saddled horse for the prize giving to give the rider the chance to be present on the horse.

Music for Freestyle Reining: possible on CD only! (no USB sticks), to be given to the show office after the arrival! Arrange a music test in time!

Prize giving ceremonies

The competitors ranked 1.-6.place have to be present in correct competition dresses on the competition horse with correct harness & saddle. If one rider have more horses, a groom has to bring this horse with saddle on hand to the ceremony and the riders has to enter this horses as well under saddle for prize giving. All this horses has to stay for the prize giving ceremony they are not allowed to leave the show ground. This horses / riders they are not following

this rules will loss their placement/etc and the next placed horse will rank higher and all others will follow of this Championship, class.
